ANNUAL REPORT OF UDAAN SOCIETY FOR THE YEAR 2004-2005

It is with great pleasure that I place before you this report of the activities of UDAAN Society for the year 2004-2005.

It is a matter of great joy for us to share with you some information about our on going programme through UDAAN Society. We are successfully moving ahead in executing various leadership programmes and facilitating to build up leadership qualities among the marginalized and also for volunteers in various areas. We are also privileged to be a partner with you in carrying out different people oriented programme.

We are now in our 1<sup>st</sup> year of our work as the registered society came into existence on 13<sup>th</sup> of December 2004. We feel a great confidence in working towards our vision '**To build an integral society based on Equality, Justice and Peace**'. It is a time to renew the existing policies and strengthen our commitment to the development of an equitable, just and peaceful society.

Voluntary work was undertaken with immense zeal and enthusiasm this year. Community organization, skill trainings etc. were given great importance and were implemented with fervor to enable people to live with dignity. Commendable efforts were made in ensuring people's participation as partners in development. This (ideology) permeated into every sphere of UDAAN Society activities and programmes. It called for an effective decentralization, not merely a transfer of financial resources but a change in focus- a change whereby people become decision- makers and important actors in the process of development.

A brief look into the activities and programmes carried out by the UDAAN Society during the year is as follows: -

1. **Road Safety Week**:- From 5-01-05 to 11-01-05 road safety week was organized under the banner of UDAAN. In this week programmes were organized to aware people about precaution to be taken when itinerant. Secretary Lalit Upadhyay and Director Yogendra Singh took charge of the awareness campaign in Aligarh Urban and nearby blocks of Lodha.
2. **National Youth Week**:-\_On the occasion of Swami Vivekanand Birth Anniversary (National Youth date) week long celebrations were organized. From 12-01-05 to 19-01-05 speeches, drawing, essay competition, sport competition etc. were organized. Indian Social Welfare and Research Institute, Aligarh cooperated fervently in the programme.

3. **International Women day:-** ‘International Women Day’ was celebrated at Muslim Public School, Nagla Jamalpur. Smt. Leelawati President (District) of Samajwadi Women cell took participation as Chief Guest. On this occasion a ‘SANKALP PAPER’ was signed by all the participant women and sent to President, UP State Women Commission Smt. Ranjana Vajpeyi.



4. **Active participation in Polio Programme:-** Message Broadcasting Vehicle message on the issues of Health, Pulse Polio and Routine Immunization was started on dated 26-02-05. Chief Medical Officer, Aligarh. Dr. K.K. Chauhan, District Malaria Officer, Shri Rajesh Sharma, Councilor ward 46 Yogesh Singhal, volunteers of UDAAN and community people were part of organization.



- On Booth day (Polio Sunday) dated 27-02-05 with the participation of children ‘Bulawa Toli’ to immunize all the target children of 0-5 years and to motivate the parents was formed. The idea behind formation of ‘Bulawa toli’ was to cover all the children on Booth Day. Inauguration of booths was done was District Malaria Officer, Shri Rajesh Verma and Sector Incharge Dr. Anand Shahnam.
- In order to mobilize all the resistant/reluctant families UDAAN volunteers took participation in House to House activities of polio programme (A and B team). From dated 28-02-05 to 05-03-05 volunteers in Upperfort area did mobilization activities for the same under the able guidance of Sector Supervisor.



- Nomination in District Vector Born Disease Control Society :-** Under the President ship of District magistrate District Vector Born Disease Control Society was formed and Secretary UDAAN Society was nominated as Member of this society on dated 15-03-05.



- Participation in Pilot Project of Municipal Cooperation:** - In cooperation with Commissioner, Municipal Corporation Shri V.K. Diwedi and Nagar Swastha Adikari, Dr. Yogendra Sharma pilot project on sanitation in urban slum was launched. Members of society organized group meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> of April 05 in the urban sector of Hamdrad Nagar D, Jamalpur to sensitize community on the importance of sanitation, health and poverty. Volunteers of society also conduct a survey to know how sanitation habits in the community subsequently awareness drives was organized for the **behavioral change and importance of sanitation.**



- Coordination with National/ International Organizations:-**

To establish the identity of organization at national and international level personal contact and correspondence through email and surface mail was made through out the year. District level officer's representatives of national and international level organization viz. Unicef, WHO, CARE, ACTION AID, CASA, USAID, UNDP, UNFPA, CRY, SHAHBHAGI, PRIA, UPVAN, VHAI, AVARD, SIRD, UPSWC, NACO, SACS, CWYC, NYKS, OXFAM, Rotary International, John Hopkins University, Baltimore were contacted and oriented on the on objectives, mission, vision and activities of society. JHU also sent valuable material on RCH, Training, organizational development, CNA, STD/RTI/UTI, HIV/AIDS etc. the of which will be in the proving quality training and sensitization of volunteers and community people.

- NGO networking :-**

Networking with different local level organizations with objective of forming a platform for the advocacy on issues related to common man was done. The future planning for this networking is to form intersectoral coordination committee for the uniformity in

implementation of programmes. Lata Gramudyog Sansthan, Atrauli, Vishva Dalit Parishad, Ahinsa Foundation, Aligarh Gram Vikas Sansthan, ladoua Aligarh, ASSWA Aligarh, Indian Social Welfare and Research Institute, Aligarh, Jan Vikas Samiti, Aligarh, Yuva Janhitkari Seva Samiti, Dholpur, Shri Krishna Vikas Sansthan, Phusapur, Alwar, Chirag, Firozabad, and local level NGO's were contacted during the period.

9. **Republic day celebration:-** 26<sup>th</sup> January 2005 was celebrated as republic day at registered office of society. After flag assent ceremony national anthem was sang by all the participants. Youths of the organization present cultural programme on this occasion.

10. **Child Rally :-** On booth day 25<sup>th</sup> February 2005 Pulse Polio Awareness rally was organized in areas of Jamal pur, Hamdard nagar 'A' , 'B', 'C', 'D' Dhoora Mafi and Shahjamal area of Aligarh urban. Sweets were distributed among children.



11. For the update in recent events in the arena of social work as well as happenings of organization training, orientation and meetings of volunteers and members of Governing body are been organized.



12. **Health Camps :-**

To generate health awareness and motivate masses on the health sensitive issues 5 health camps were organized in urban area of Aligarh in the month of January. The idea behind organizing these health camps was to sensitize community on the basic health problems as well as to provide on the spot counseling service to the patients. Referral services, medicines, immunization, blood slide collection for malarial parasite test were the key facilities provided in the camp. In all 835 patients were registered 112 children were immunized and ANC check up of 83 women was done.
